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| Google Forms is an amazing tool that allows you to collect a wide variety of data from your students digitally. You can create surveys, quizzes, exit tickets, and tests. The data from this tool is collected in one place (a single Google Sheet) and can be accessed from your Google Drive, therefore eliminating the stacks and stacks of papers.
