Detailed Description of Use:
<p>AnswerGarden provides for real-time feedback participations and brainstorming among students and/or educators in a classroom setting. After setting up the tool, teachers can pose a question that is reflected on a screen and on individual devices. As the answers and ideas are entered, they appear on the "garden" in a word cloud-type format, with more frequently mentioned responses appearing more prominently on the screen. AnswerGarden allows for anonymous responses. No log-ins are needed - the teacher would simply provide a link to the question. AnswerGardens can also be embedded within a teacher's blog or website. Different modes provide teachers with the ability to make adjustments for the numbers of responses allowed. Teachers can create a password that would let them edit unwanted/inappropriate responses.</p>
